### **The Course Objectives**

On completion of this course you should have cemented you're existing skills and knowledge or obtained the basic skills & knowledge to apply the following:

- Follow and apply workplace OHS procedures
- Identify hazards within the workplace
- Implement risk control measures
- Carry out equipment / vehicle inspections
- Apply effective communication skills
- Read & interpret plans & specifications
- Identify, locate & protect underground services
- Conduct measurements & calculations
- Carry out basic leveling tasks
- Carry out manual excavation tasks & repair potholes
- Complete tasks using hand & power tools
- Operate a range of small plant & equipment
- Drain & dewater work construction sites
- Correct handling / disposing of non toxic materials
- Manually spread & compact materials
- Planning & preparing for work tasks
- Support plant & equipment operations
- Conduct Elevating Work Platform Operations

The course will benefit individuals who want to advance their future career opportunities, and formalise their current skills and abilities, individuals with disabilities are also encouraged to apply.

### **Course Duration**

**Certificate II:** 2 consecutive days per week over 10 weeks, 8.30am – 4.00pm

**Skill Set:** 2 consecutive days per week over 2 weeks, 8.30am – 4.00pm *(additional training days may be required for completion of paperwork)*

**Note:** *Additional time may be required at the completion of the course in order to fulfill the licencing and operators card requirements*

- **Eligibility** - You must meet Australian Citizenship / Residency requirements and be:
  - ⇒ an applicant aged between 15 to 19 years of age  
or
  - ⇒ an applicant who is an apprentice  
or
  - ⇒ an applicant aged 20 years & over who is undertaking training in a qualification at a higher level than their previous highest level of qualification

If you fit this criteria you may be eligible to apply for a government subsidised training place under the Skills for Victoria - Victorian Training Guarantee. *(Please note that tuition, materials and amenities fees may apply.)*
